## GUIDELINES FOR SAFE OPERATIONS RELATED TO COVID-19 as of March 1, 2022

Per Illinois Great Rivers Conference guidelines, each UMC church is to ascertain what measures should remain or be modified to allow for the safety of members and guests. Specific policy guidelines are offered below. Please know that Zoom remains an option for meeting/gathering of individuals. If needed, please arrangements with church office.

In light of the decreasing risks posed by the coronavirus, Melrose Chapel UMC has adopted the following policy update:

The coronavirus continues to be present; however, its risks have decreased among much of the population. With that in mind, we are no longer strongly recommending masks and social distancing but do ask that individuals continue to observe good health practices as well as to respect the personal decisions of others regarding their own health safety. Our intent has always been to do no harm and we continue to have individuals in our midst that are either experiencing health crises of their own or who care for those that do.

On Sunday mornings, we will continue to take attendance at the door, and will provide baskets at the back of the sanctuary for giving/offering purposes. Services will be recorded for those unable to attend in person and greeting time within the service will proceed as is currently done. Classes and groups can also relax the wearing of masks and observance of social distancing, but leaders are encouraged to consult with their group members regarding their comfort in doing so.

The Emergency Preparedness Team will continue to monitor these and other needs and suggest changes as necessary.
